

## Cubis™.

830 range. Technical details.

### Function

Cube-shaped armchairs and upholstered benches with backrests, as well matching tables with wooden tops for use in informal meeting environments, such as reception areas, lobbies and foyers.

### Armchairs and upholstered benches with backrest

#### Frame

Oval aluminium hollow profile, bright chrome plated, clear or black anodized, or coated. Underside of glides in polyurethane for soft and hard floors.

#### Seat and back

Seat, backrest and side sections are solid, cushioned beech frames. Back section with flexible upper edge. Foam composite upholstery with fibre fleece underlay.

### Table

#### Frame

Oval aluminium profile, bright chrome plated, clear or black anodized, or coated. Black polyurethane glides.

#### Core material of table top

Birch plywood.

#### Table top group 1 – laminate

Table top thickness 42 mm (1<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" )  
Laminate according to Wilkhahn colour and surface finish samples. Moulded plywood edge profile, natural oiled finish.

#### Table top group 2 – veneer

Table top thickness 42 mm (1<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" )

##### Variation 1:

Beech, oak or ash veneer according to Wilkhahn woodstain colour samples. Chamfered edging, as far as possible in the same colour as the veneer.

##### Variation 2:

Maple, elm or walnut veneer, as well as Wilkhahn veneer Mocca according to Wilkhahn woodstain colour samples. Chamfered edging, as far as possible in the same colour as the veneer.

#### Veneer version


As a standard, the veneers are slip-matched onto the table top. Surfaces sealed with clear lacquer:  
Open-pore: oak, ash, walnut and elm veneer, as well as Wilkhahn veneer Mocca.  
Closed-pore: maple and beech veneer.  
Some specific growth features possible.

### Standards


Cubis armchairs and settees conform to ANSI/BIFMA X 5.4. Cubis tables conform to ANSI/BIFMA X 5.5.
