Occo is a highly versatile and beautifully simple chair and table collection made for diverse applications, including café areas, informal collaborative spaces, and conference rooms alike. With six shell colors, four frame variations, and three cushioning options, there are 72 basic chair model possibilities. In addition, multiple table shapes and table tops allow the Occo range to respond to virtually all functional and design requirements.

The Occo Chair's friendly form is attributed to varied material thicknesses throughout the shell and its characteristic cut-out. Up to ten Occo chairs may be conveniently stacked for storage (four-legged chrome-plated metal frame version only).

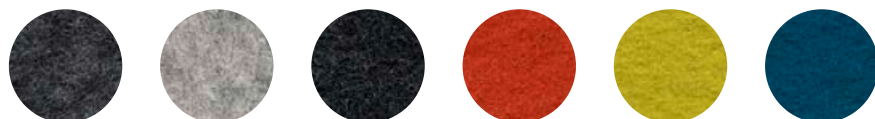

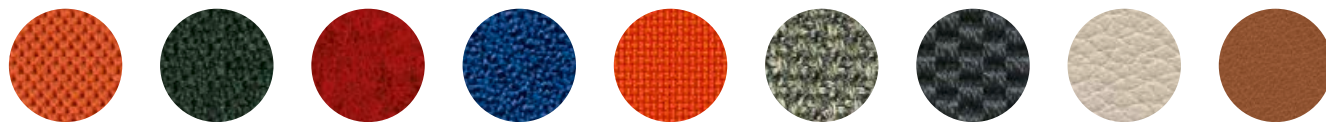

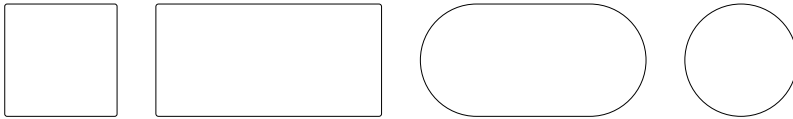

Edge profiles



Solid wood edge, rounded on the bottom, plastic lipping straight, chamfered wood edge or HPL solid core, chamfered edge

Frame versions



Bright chrome-plated tubular steel, black or white coated with a textured matte finish

Direct coating, through-dyed black/white, veneer version 1 or 2, solid wood, for further surfaces see price list or catalog
